Non-rechargeable - **more than 2 grams of lithium**

**FORBIDDEN ON PASSENGER AIRCRAFT**

Rechargeable - **above 160 Wh**

**Must only be carried as Cargo/Freight in accordance with DG Regulations**

Watt hours (Wh) = Amps (Ah) x Voltage (v)

SPARE BATTERIES MAY NOT BE PLACED IN CHECKED BAGGAGE AT ANY TIME

BATTERIES CONTAINED IN EQUIPMENT MUST BE SWITCHED OFF AND PROTECTED FROM ACCIDENTAL ACTIVATION

**ANY OTHER BATTERY TYPE NOT LISTED MUST BE ASSESSED BY THE DG COORDINATOR AND MAY REQUIRE DG ACCEPTANCE VIA A FREIGHT AGENT**
